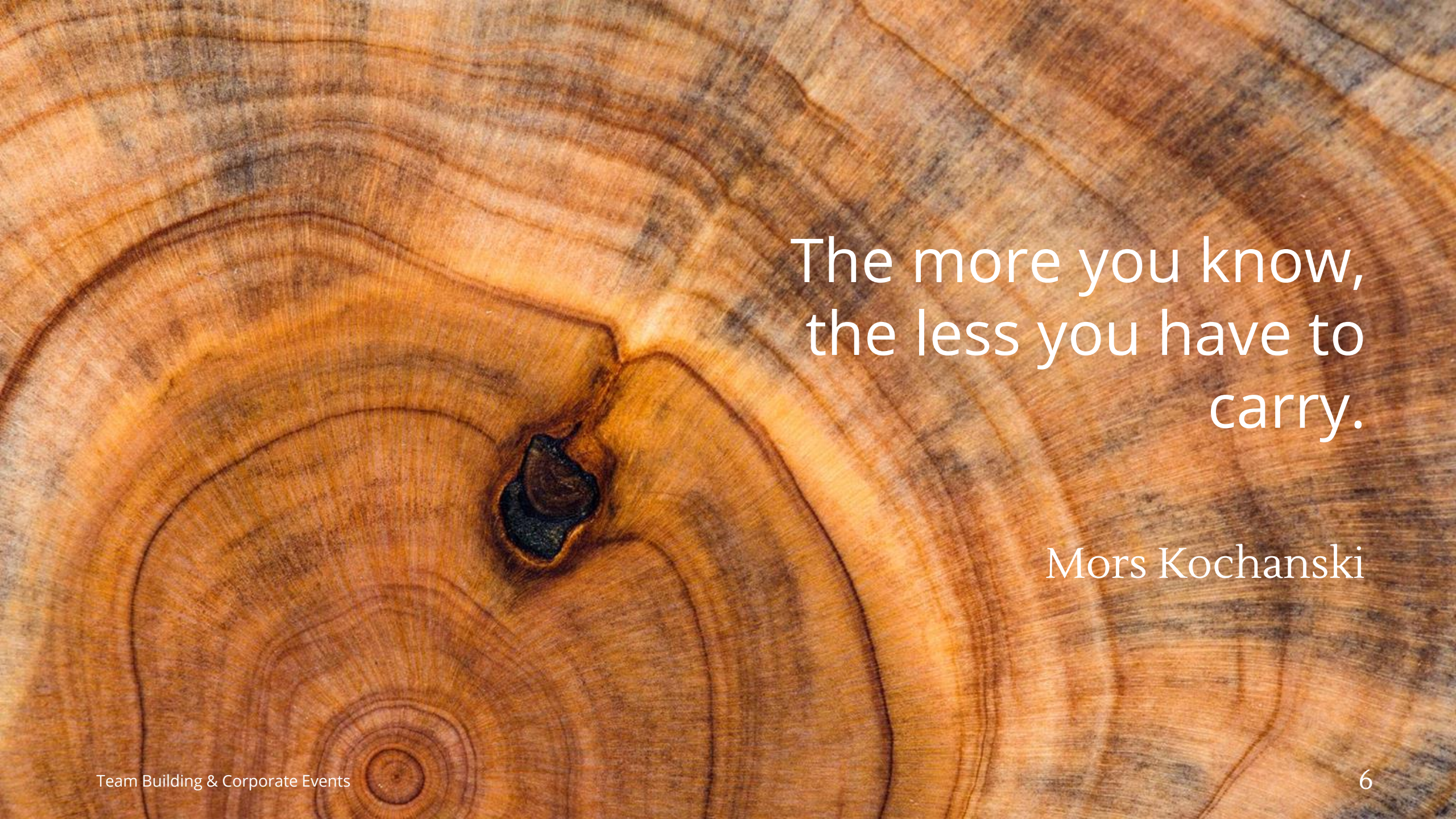

- Sleeping is available either on tents or shelters

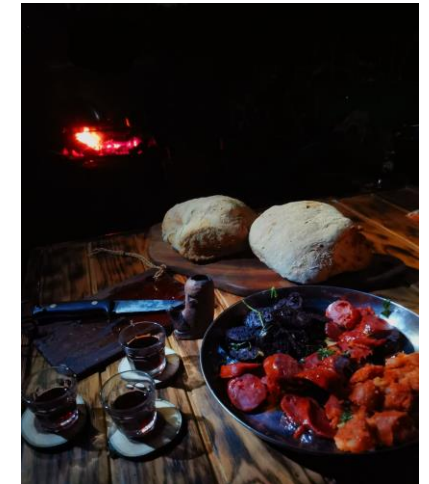
MENU
